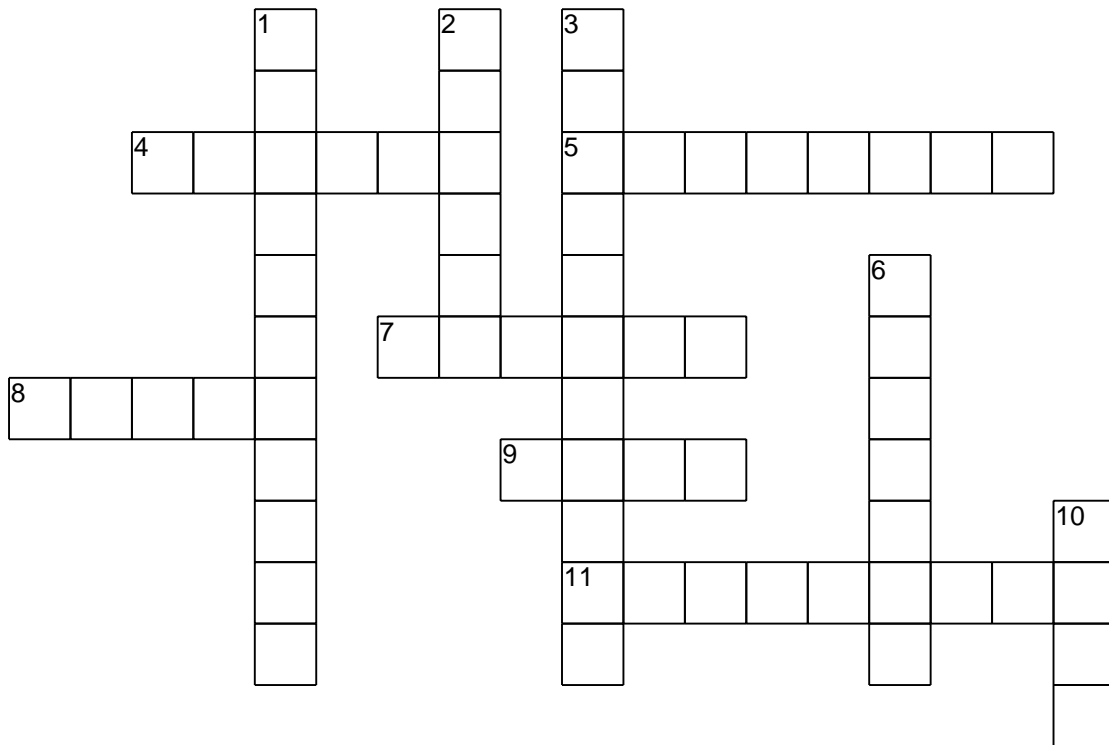
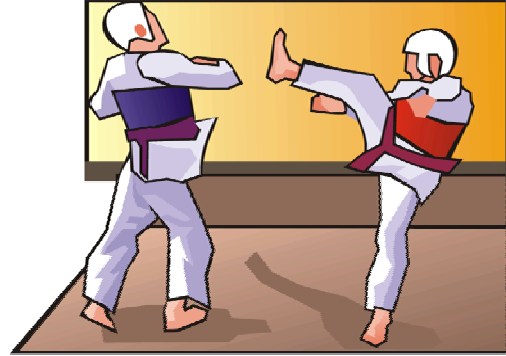

ACROSS

- Eight in Korean, ending the mandatory eight-count a downed contestant must take even if he wants to resume sparring
- A point
- The referee's command to get ready to start the contest
- The contestant wearing blue
- The number ten in Korean, indicating the end of a full count and, hence, a knockout
- A Korean martial art, meaning way of hands and feet

- The area of the opponent's face or body where a legitimate strike may be made to score a point
- The referee's command to break, or move away from a downed opponent
- A method of resolving a tie by playing a fourth round in which the first person to score is the winner
- A penalty that automatically costs a contestant a point
